## RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp was present at the meeting! The history lesson was from RR magazine May 1947 - Test Run, by RB Nixon. This was the story of the Northern Pacific RR first diesel run with no change of locomotive en-route, with dyno car, several coaches and a few more cars. The loco was No. 754, an EMD three unit demonstrator. Only EMD and a few RR people were allowed to ride the train. The run was from St. Paul to Seattle and the train ran on schedule with an hour stop at several stations. Word of this special train got out and large crowds met the train at several stops. The diesel powered train ran in the 80-90 mph range! It hit and ran through the 2% Rocky Mountain grades with ease. The total time of the run, 33 hours and 56 minutes! THANKS John! We're looking forward to another lesson soon.




