RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp was present at the meeting! The history lesson was from Trains Magazine March 1965 -WHERE 19TH CENTURY RAIL CAR FERRIES ARE! The Lansdown - side paddle wheeler ferry 1884 built. Steel hull with wood superstructure. Operates 7-9 months per year. The Huron, another ferry built in 1875 works when the Lansdown is in service and off season. Built in England, disassembled and reassembled in Ontario, opposite Port Huron. Lansdown had a historical society formed! Both ships were reaching their 100 year anniversaries at the time of the article! Foot note - the Lansdown became a "floating" restaurant, moored along the Detroit River for many years and used several rail passenger cars for the actual restaurant! (including a Hiawatha observation car.) THANKS John! We're looking forward to another lesson soon.


