
## CLINIC

WE ALWAYS NEED CLINICS for our meetings! Please contact Clinic Chairman Byrne Blumenstein to get your clinic scheduled! PLEASE share your talents and knowledge! Our clinic this past month was by Div 8 member Greg Rich, MMR. Rich has a great way to carve rocks from Styrofoam! He showed a series of short video's that showed stepby-step how to do the carving and painting. WOW! This looked easy to do and came out looking great! At first, it looked almost hap-hazard and crazy, but by the end... it popped and looked great !! A side story was had on the oatmeal scenery material that many use. Some use Vermiculite. Others are using Zonolite. For Zonolite the current price is about \$16.95 for a 4 cu. ft. bag. That is a lot of material and is enough to fill a garbage/trash can. The best place to get it in this area is at MasonPro, 43300 Seven Mile, Northville, MI 48167 248-347-3824. Vermiculite was a little too thick and the Zonolite allows for a finer texture.
