d) use the RAISE HAND feature to ask to speak to the group or unmute and ask your question if the other person has stopped talking. Re-mute when done.

e) Please be aware that everyone can see YOU! And hear you and what is happening around you! Be kind!! These simple rules will help everyone hear what needs to be said and help the meeting use our time more effectively! THANKS!!
