RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp was present online at the meeting and thus, we had a history lesson.... Railroad car Ferries of the lower Great Lakes. John's main sources were The Great Lakes Car Ferries by George W. Hilton and The Bessemer and Lake Erie Railroad 1869-1969 by Roy C. Beaver, along with photos found online. In the first half of the 20th century 4 railroad car ferry lines operated across Lake Erie and Ontario. All were jointly owned by a US and a Canadian railroad and were set up primarily to haul coal to ports in southern Ontario. The Marquette and Bessemer Dock and Navigation Co, was operated by the Pere

Marquette and the Bessemer and Lake Erie out of Conneaut, Ohio, to 3 ports in Ontario. This line's vessels had an unfortunate history. The Shenango No.1 was lost to fire and the Marguette and Bessemer No.2 was lost with all hands in a winter storm. The Marguette and Bessemer No.1 was a collier of a most unusual design. Hoppers were loaded on deck and coal was dumped into the ship's hold through hatches in the deck. The hoppers were then removed and the ship sailed. Coal traffic declined through the depression and the line was abandoned in 1932. The PRR and the CP Railway jointly formed the Pennsylvania-Ontario Transportation Co in 1906 to sail between Ashtabula, Ohio and Port Burwell, Ontario. The line operated for 52 years until their only ferry, the Ashtabula, was sunk in September, 1958, ending ferry service on the lower lakes. The Toronto Hamilton & Buffalo Navigation Company was the shortest lived of the lines. It operated between Ashtabula and Port Maitland, Ontario, from 1916 to 1932. The lone Lake Ontario ferry line was the Ontario Car Ferry Company. Owned by the Grand Trunk and the Buffalo Rochester and Pittsburgh, it began service between Rochester, NY and Cobourg, Ontario in 1907. In addition to coal, this line had good passenger business, complete with a boat train scheduled to connect with each northbound sailing. By 1950 traffic had fallen dramatically when Canada issued tightened standards for passenger vessels. The line chose not to upgrade their old ferries and the service ended.

In an additional History lesson from Byrne Blumenstein - from Railway Weekly 1964. In 1964 the Santa Fe Railroad was planning to use nuclear explosions to clear mountains at that time. What were they thinking? Looking forward to another history lesson soon!! Thanks John and Byrne!!




