

RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp gave us another interesting lesson this past month. John gave us the story of The Stilwell Oyster car. It seems that in the late 1800's - early 1900's, oysters became all the rage to eat. Railroads tried to get these to market as fast as possible, but didn't succeed well. The Long Island RR had 4 special trains to transport oysters to NYC. In 1897, Arthur Stilwell designed a special car to make this possible. It was basically a rectangular tank car that held the oysters and the sea water that helped keep them fresh. This design was patented and one car was built by the Pullman Co. It seems that success was very limited and the car only lasted until 1905. It was the only one ever built.

Region (ours), the Mid-West and the Mid-Central Regions are the three regions that are sponsoring this event. Clinics, layout tours and train show are all planned.


NCR NEWS
