Our subject was your smallest **locomotive!** Here's what was shared- Matchbox 0-2-0 ; GE 45ton; Plymouth ML8 switcher; 4-4-0 Loco; Bachmann Little Giant switcher; Varney 0-4-0T; steam loco bracelet charm 1" long; Lionel 2-4-2; Atlas rubber-band drive switcher; 2-2-2 steam loco clock; GN 0-6-0; GE 44ton N scale; P2K SW1200; Ma&Pa 4-6-0; RDG boxcab; 0-6-0 SP in 0 scale; PRR SW9 N scale; 0-4-0 Dockside O scale; Soo NW2; 0-6-0 road loco from Larry Wright; 0-6-0 N scale switcher; HO Gandy Dancer; 0-4-0 Mini-Tonka; HO track-mobile; GE 25t in G scale and (winner?) a 4"x3" sardine can working layout with a loco about 1/4" long!!

RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp gave us another interesting lesson this past month. John gave us the story of the Heinz Company House Cars, their origins and use. These were used from the late 1890's to 1915's. They were mostly insulated boxcars, refrig cars and special tank cars. They would certainly come under the "Banner" type of cars as they were colorful and basically a rolling ad for the company and products. The box and refrig cars carried mostly finished products, plus some raw materials. The infamous pickle tank cars carried those in a brine solution and also plain vinegar. Records show there were about 174 cars of different types in 1908, but by 1929 all were gone and the company was using regular cars from the local railroads.



Nice and interesting information on cars we all know of, but not about their history! Looking forward to another history lesson soon!! Thanks John!!


