Our clinics this past month were by Div 6 member Scott Kremer, MMR on building catenary! Scott showed some photos of the prototype to give us a basic lesson on what, how and why the catenary system works. Then he showed drawings of the model parts, then how he modeled catenary using brass poles and components. Some parts are easily bought from several manufacturers. Looks fairly easy! Scott then showed the installation on his layout in photos and a video. Very cool! Scott's catenary is not "live", but really gives a great impression on his layout. Very nice work! Great information!

Byrne, our clinic coordinator, also talked about doing virtual roundtable clinics... something short, 15 minutes, tips on how to do something that anyone can present.

Byrne also had an idea of doing "Layout Vinettes" where a member would show a picture or two of a scene on their layout and describe how they did that scene. Again, thinking these could take about 15 minutes and we could do a few each meeting.

RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp gave us another interesting lesson this past month. John gave us the story of the Locos of Ross Winans. Ross was an inventor and also designed and built steam locos in 1840-50's. He had several unique designs, the first being the "Crab". This was a 4 wheel vertical boiler loco built for the B&O. Next came the "Mud Digger" which was an 8 wheel vertical boiler loco. Another design was the "Juno" a 4-4-0 more conventional loco design. But Winan's most popular and well known design was the "Camel", a for-runner of camelback locos.



The Camel had a very large steam dome, unique firebox hanging from the rear frame and a unique smoke stack design. These were built and purchased by several railroads and some lasted 50 years in various forms. Many were rebuilt with more conventional features. Winan's loco business closed in 1860 after building over 260 locos. Looking forward to another history lesson soon!! Thanks John!!
