John Bopp was present at the meeting and had quite the history lesson. The History of compound steam locos; 20-30% proposed savings in efficiency but more like 10% in real practice. ATSF used many. Several different type and manufacturers of these types of locos; John showed pictures of the many types and styles. Compounds were approx. 33-23% of total loco production. They waned after 1900. Super-heater system also made the compound not necessary and also made them obsolete. Thanks John! Looking forward to another soon!

At a special zoom meeting on Jan 6th, near 30 members of Div 6 listened to a presentation by Terry Kosmas and Barry Hensel on a proposal to raise money for the Div 6 treasury. Our bank account is low and we have a convention to run in 2 years, our meetings are costing \$600 a year. This all takes a toll on our account and it needs shored up. Terry and Barry presented the idea that Div 6 should host a regular train show/sale type of event. They showed and talked about the concept, some of the details of what the event would be like, how many volunteers would be needed and the possible income estimating Div 6 could take in \$1000 or more. That, would be a great boost to the treasury! This event would take place this spring, in April/May at the latest. Then, the event would move to a mid-January date in 2023, filling the hole that the Avondale Train show has left. There are no local train shows in mid-January, since that show cancelled a few years ago. A few questions were asked and answered and, in the end, the membership voted YES to continue to work toward hosting this event! Lots more work is to be done and a full report will be given at the January Div 6 meeting. We hope to have location, date and costs all ready for approval.
