RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp was present at the meeting and gave another history lesson. A FAST LOOK AT FAST FREIGHT LINES After the civil war there was no interchange due to many track gauges and RR's thought of all other RR's as competition and to be avoided. Kasson's Despatch service on NYC seemed to solve this problem in the 1850's used his own cars and staff to track shipments. His business merged to MDT Corp (Merchants Despatch Transportation) after Kasson passed. MDT became most well-known for NYC refer car service, but had their own design before partnering with NYC and other RR's. Another was the Empire Line that was similar, working through the PRR. Transported oil barrels empty and also later had tank cars. A third, Union Line started in the mid 1880's, was a private line, but became a co-op line owned by many railroads. The Blue Line also worked through NYC and Mich Central in 1891 and became a co-op line. There were up to 40 of these fast freight lines! A few others were - Erie and North Shore, ran in MI in 1870's in downtown area near MI Central Depot; Great Eastern Line was HO in Detroit. The 1890's saw decline in fast freight lines as RR's made their own services. Interesting information! Thanks John! We're looking forward to another soon! BTW - John's history lessons are
