CLINIC

WE ALWAYS NEED CLINICS for our meetings! Please contact Clinic Chairman Byrne Blumenstein to get your clinic scheduled! PLEASE share your talents and knowledge! The clinic for this month was by Div 6 member and Historian John Bopp. John showed how to use the Library of Congress Sanborn Insurance Company Map collection for railroad related research. From 1868 through 1961 the Sanborn Map Company produced maps of something like 12,000 cities and towns in the United States, Canada, and Mexico. These largescale maps show commercial, industrial, and residential areas of these places as well as the locations of railroad structures and tracks. These maps can provide a valuable resource for modelers. Over 35,000 images of these maps are available, free, on line from the Library of Congress at https://www.loc.gov/collections/sa *nborn-maps/* John provided a step-by-step example of how to find the track plan for the Fort Street Union Depot in the 1921-1950 map of Detroit in the Library of Congress collection. He then used the 1884 Sanborn map of Detroit to find the location of a photo from the Burton Historical Collection of the Detroit Public Library showing boxcars on the Michigan Central in Detroit. The photo was captioned 16th Street Bridge but the Sanborn map shows the location of the bridge was actually at 15th Street. John also found the location for the prototype of a kit for the J.F. Wiessner/American Brewery in Baltimore, Maryland. The kit is supposed to be for a lineside industry but the Sanborn map shows it was never served by rail! Interesting info and thought provoking! Thanks John!
