



RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp was at the September meeting and gave this lesson....

Michigan Central RR. Part I -"Riverfront". The clinic was a timeline with photos. Information from the Detroit Pubic Library. Michigan became a State in 1837 US government gave 5 million to Michigan to help fund 3 railroads. By 1841, none of the three railroads were finished. 1846 Michigan sold the Railroads to private companies. 1846 Michigan Central RR bought one of the lines. The Michigan Central then ran from Buffalo Ohio to Detroit. 1847 Michigan Central RR (MCRR) bought land and built a station at 3rd Street and Woodbridge in Detroit called "Detroit Terminance". It contained a Domed Roundtable. 1850 Detroit Terminance burned in fire (maybe set by arson. Local farmers?) 1875 New GRAIN HOUSE ELEV A was build. Round table was turned into car shops. Grain box car could unload into GRAIN HOUSE. Ship could dock on the Detroit River and load grain from the HOUSE. 1884 New station with clock tower 1897 "UNION STATION" built with ferry slip to CANADA down the street on River Road (later called Jefferson Ave). 1873-93 A new ELEV B was built. New trackage was added to the area connecting the Station and GRAND JCT (now WEST DETROIT JCT). Neat information on our local history! Thanks John! We're looking forward to another lesson soon!

DEEPEST SYMPATHIES

Division 6 has lost a long time member, Ed Joppich. Ed passed on Tuesday, Oct 3. He was 91 years old. Ed, father of past Superintendent Glenn Joppich, has been a Div 6 member for many



years and participated in many of our events like the Fall Show and layout tours. Ed had a very nice size Erie RR HO layout in the basement of his condo. He is survived by his wife Edee and their 5 children. Ed also had 13 grandchildren and 7 greatgrandchildren! Besides model railroading, Ed was a very accomplished Architect and was very active in Detroit area Catholic ministries. Deepest sympathies to Glenn and the entire Joppich family.

THE OBSERVATION CAR

Sitting on a tourist railroad a few weeks ago I found myself thinking back to a question I raised at a Division 6 meeting some time back: How many of those in attendance had actually ridden a revenue passenger train. I was shocked by the fact that the majority replied that they had never really been on a train - we all just look at and model them. Does anybody other than me find that truly ironic! What's wrong with this picture?

Of course, the handful of us who had lived in New York, Chicago, or Washington were likely at the opposite end of the spectrum. Out of curiosity I did a rough estimate on how many trips I personally had made on the New York subway system while I lived there, and it worked out to around 6,000 rides, and like most New Yorkers, gave relatively little thought about finding those trains interesting, even after riding the subway thousands of times. Talk about missed opportunities!

I think the lesson here is that, if we all were REALLY interested

in trains, the least we should be doing is actually trying to experience them from the inside - be it Amtrak, or the vast mass transit systems that offer a different experience every time you look out the window or the door. I'll bet that it not only opens an even greater emotional connection with railroading but gives you lots of ideas for modeling stations and passenger train interactions.

By the way, one of the very good clinics in Dallas at the NMRA Convention was on all the "stuff" you will see if you look around when you are at a train terminal, and that would be great new ideas for our layouts. For example, fuel and cleaning fluid supply tanks, layover track for Pullman sleepers awaiting a connection, commissaries for all the food, tablecloth, bedding and cleaning supplies, passenger car cleaning tracks, Pullman RIP tracks, etc. So, for those of you who have not yet ridden a train, you really should not just watch trains, but actually get on board!
