The clinic this past month was by member Bill McMillan - static grass tufts handmade! Bill used a new device, a static grass deck machine by "Grass Box". War World Scenics brand. About \$70 on Amazon. Here's a linkhttps://www.wwscenics.com/product/ pro-grass-box-applicator-wws/ This is a different type of machine to make static grass. Most of us use the shaker style which is good for open areas, but not good for small detailed areas. Grass Box makes tufts, grass rows or even flexible grass mats very easily! Bill went through all the supplies needed and showed how to do the tufts. Very interesting! NOTE - Don't forget the gloves!! Bill had a PPT presentation plus video's showing methods. 

The convention is Oct 10-13, 2024. Our site is Ward Church in Northville. Another meeting was held with the planning Team and we're working on the event outline and other details. Our next


meeting is


