#### RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp was at the August meeting but we did not have time for a lesson. Sorry! We're looking forward to another lesson soon!

#### THE OBSERVATION CAR

Having just returned from the NMRA national convention in Dallas, I thought I'd pass on three of my best experiences there.

The first was the tour to the BNSF National Operations Center. This amazing building is responsible for all operations across the entire railroad and sits in a secure (and tornado hardened) building with thousands of employees. After seeing some of the awesome railroad art, as well as model and equipment collections compiled over 150 years by the leadership of the various railroads, we were brought into the main auditorium overlooking the national control room. You were looking down on a room fronted by the largest railroad network management screens in the country with several hundred people on the floor or working off it. Think of the image of the NASA launch control room, increased to the size of a football field, with many times the number of people.

The second stop on the tour was the Alliance intermodal yard for a real closeup of exactly what goes on, how equipment is handled, and just what the crews have to do. With it being 110 degrees that day, the crews themselves had to routinely deal with 120+ temps due to all the dark steel equipment they work with. They had to wear, not just gloves, but long sleeve shirts to reduce the likelihood of getting burned if they touched a container or car.

The last item I found truly interesting was at the convention center itself, where Mini-Prints had set up a 3D scanning laser, in front of a turntable. An attendee could stand on the turntable as it rotated while the laser scanned them, which then sent to a 3D printer, creating a 3D copy of the person - in whatever scale you model. So, I will soon have 5 copies of myself in HO scale to place on my layout! How is that for a landscaping feature!

More experiences at one of our next meetings. Byrne







The railroad is 26' x 23'. featuring a walk around point-to-point design with traffic from connections in Houghton staging to the terminus in Calumet. It has scratch-built and kitbashed structures. Scenery is 95% complete but an expansion is planned.

My Green River Subdivision of the Boston & Maine is a fictional division running north from the Maine coast through the mountains toward Berlin, New Hampshire. The railroad is set in the late 1950's and is still running steam along with first generation diesel. The emphasis is on capturing the New England scenery and providing a stage setting for my operations sessions. The railroad is designed for operations with 8 to 10 persons.
