



I saw some kids that I think could be future model railroaders. Why? 1. Because someone brought them to the show. 2. Someone that brought them has an interest in model trains. Can Division 6 capture that interest and have them join NMRA?

The North Central Region saw a small increase in membership this past year. Also, the NMRA saw a small increase in the membership as well. That has not happened in several years. #### RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp was at the January meeting and gave us a great look at the Niagara Falls RR suspension bridge! The bridge was 825 long and a two-level bridge. The top platform was for a single-track railroad crossing. The bottom deck was for horse-carriage and pedestrians. The upper level was raised with inclines to and from it, while the lower deck was ground level. Because the bridge was built before track gauge was standardized, the upper deck had extra rails to accommodate 3 track gauges! The bridge was rebuilt several times and improved each time. Thanks John! We're looking forward to another lesson soon!

#### THE OBSERVATION CAR

In talking with some visitors to our Division 6 booth at the Novi Train Show, and again at our sale, I noticed that almost everyone is focused almost entirely on rolling stock, i.e. the trains and the engines and cars that make them up. As almost everyone in the hobby will confirm, we probably spend way more time on everything that surrounds the rolling stock than on the trains.

Creating structures, doing scenery, building track, and creating an operating environment is as much a part of the hobby as the trains. That said, we probably need to do a better job of promoting all the "stuff" that goes WITH the "trains" when we talk to people.

For example, in conversation with some folks who expressed an interest in the hobby at our booths, the most interesting discussions were on DCC, scenery and trackwork, yet we really had little on display to talk to potential members about.

While the modular layouts we display get lots of interest, I propose that we start creating a separate display that will show the amazing things we can do with structures, scenery, and backgrounds. The typical laser kit, or very detailed scene I think will really open some eyes for things they didn't know much of the hobby was about.

I'd also suggest a small display that draws in those inspired by electronics, 3D printing, laser cutting, and most specifically, some of what you can do with DCC and LCC vs DC. I've been reading that those areas appear to be drawing in the newer generations of hobbyists.

So, food for thought. Let's get potential members interested in things that DON'T have wheels. How is that for thinking outside the box(car)!






