WHO WE ARE

We are Division 6 of the North Central Region (NCR) of the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA). What that means is, the NMRA is the model railroad association for the country (and even world). The country is divided into REGIONS, which are one or more states. Our Region, the North Central Region (NCR), is all of Michigan and the northern part of Ohio and Indiana. Each Region is then divided into DIVISIONS, which are one or more counties. Division 6 is primarily Wayne County, but we have many members from western Oakland County and we aren't strict on membership and boundaries. Oakland and Macomb Counties are Division 8, the Ann Arbor area is Division 9 and a new Division has been formed in the Flint-Saginaw area. All total, there are about 8 Divisions in our Region.

RAILROAD HISTORY

Prof. Norm gave his first History lesson for our Div 6 meeting, last month. "When Eastern MI rode the Rails" was Norm's title for his clinic and the book where the information came from. Did you know, that Michigan and the Detroit area was the best city for all types of transportation systems. We had it all! Street Cars, busses, interurbans, trains, steam ships and autos. And it was the auto that did them all in! Transportation change happened in Michigan/Detroit faster than any other major city or state. It started with stagecoach lines in the 1800's, which did become railroad lines. In 1836 the Erie & Kalamazoo RR started with horse drawn coaches and wooden rails. 1863 saw horse drawn street cars, which became all electric by 1895. With autos starting in the early 1900's, by the 1930's the street car made it's last run. 1956 saw the last interurban run in our area. Norm's story covered all of the area cities, especially those here in our area- Plymouth, Wayne, Ypsilanti, Ann Arbor, Novi, etc. Great info and history... and that is what Prof Norm is all about! Looking forward to another lesson next month.

MODELING INFORMATION

We did have a few questions at the meeting.

** using hard board for backdrop, how to do joints? First try to bevel the edges at the joints, like drywall and then use plaster and joint tape like you would do with drywall. Sand and paint and you should be all set.

** Kato Locos with same number, how to change? To remove road numbers without damaging paint there are many different methods... ink eraser, decal remover/stripper lightly used, denatured alcohol are a few. Another way would be to match the paint as close as possible, paint out the original numbers and then re-decal over the new paint. The real railroads even do it that way!

** what might you use for the floor/ground cover for a stock yard? Real dirt, sawdust were mentioned. For loose straw how about some hemp rope cut into small pieces and glued down all over. Thanks for your questions and answers! We look forward to more questions and tips next month!
