RAILROAD HISTORY

History "Prof" Norm was present and had a story on the DT&I. Tying in to the show & tell theme of layout planning, Norm told us about some planning of the DT&I. First planning was by canals from Lake Erie to the Ohio River. Railroads then followed that example! Early ties to railroad plans were from 1849! Move ahead to the early 1920's and Ford Co. purchased the DT&I as it was "in his way". The railroad soon became a huge advantage for the auto industry, especially his! Connecting with many east-west railroads, "we have connections" soon became the railroads motto. However, after only several years, Ford sold the DT&I in 1929 to a company that had ties to the PRR. In the early 1980's, railroad mergers were rampant. The DT&I was bought by GT, who was owned by CN. As the ink was drying on the deal, it was being divided up and sold in pieces... until it was no more. Looking forward to another lesson next month.

CLINIC

This months clinic was done by Div 6 member John Wissenger on layout planning. The clinic is from 1975 and has been added to. No wrong way to design, but there are better ways. When this clinic was made, computers were not really around, especially pc's at home and thus this did not cover cad design of a layout. A sketch is a good start, but needs refined! Plans for a plan- goal, available space, features, etc. John covered each part of the plan, using an old layout space he had from a previous home as an example. John's slide presentation was very good and showed many different aspects of how this layout was designed and built. Some of the clinic updates are photos of Johns current layout. Nicely done John!! 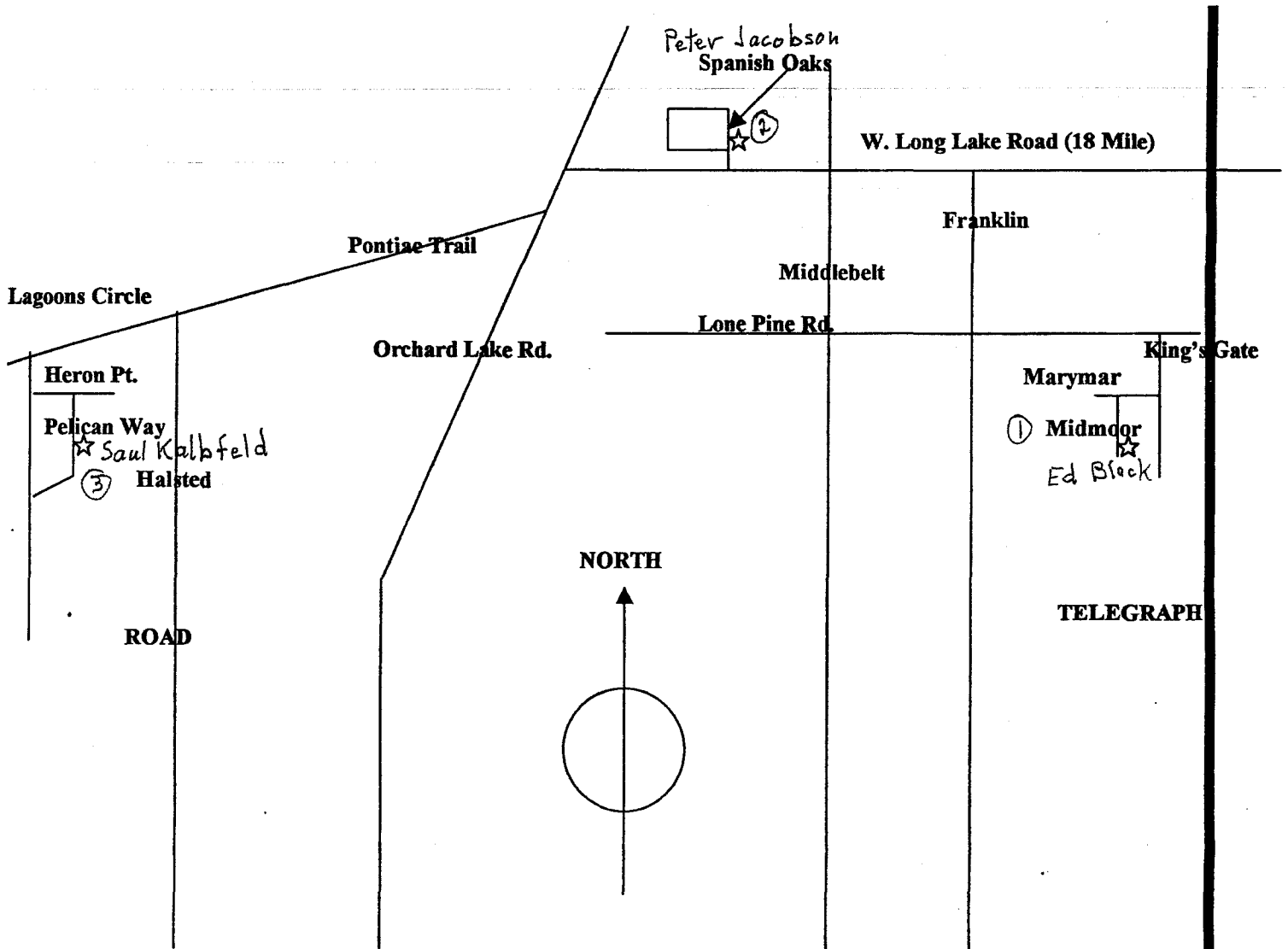
MODELING INFORMATION
