WHO WE ARE

We are Division 6 of the North Central Region (NCR) of the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA). What that means is, the NMRA is the model railroad association for the country (and even world). The country is divided into REGIONS, which are one or more states. Our Region, the North Central Region (NCR), is all of Michigan and the northern part of Ohio and Indiana. Each Region is then divided into DIVISIONS, which are one or more counties. Division 6 is primarily Wayne County, but we have many members from western Oakland County and we aren't strict on membership and boundaries. Oakland and Macomb Counties are Division 8, the Ann Arbor area is Division 9 and a new Division has been formed in the Flint-Saginaw area. All total, there are about 8 Divisions in our Region.

MODELING INFORMATION

We did have a few questions/tips at the meeting,

** TIP on FREE material - Bill Rubarth showed us a material, usually black, plastic and has a pattern on it that looks like diamond plate. Bill used it on a tofc car for the bridge plates. It could also be used for treadways and walkways. Where to get this material? Try Home Depot... and it should be FREE ... it's the BANDING for lumber... they throw it away! ** Need help shaking those paint bottles? Graham Brown has a homemade paint shaker. Made of some brass stock it has a cradle that is the size of a typical paint bottle and a stem. The flat stem fits into a jiq saw like the blade, screw it down and turn on the saw to shake the paint bottles! Sounds like a "how to do" article for the HotBox! ** Question- sprung trucks - how to keep springs in - thought of acc glue to one end. I don't remember if anyone really had an answer for this, other than sprung trucks are bad for DCC layouts and many do not use them.

** Question- MDC shay kits, need parts- looking for scrap loco for parts, please call Frank Spadafore at 313-271-7308

CLINIC

Div 6 member Mark Ellis gave us a clinic on layout animation. He talked about types of animationmotion, sound, and light. To show examples, Mark showed us pictures of a visit to the ChooChoo Barn in PA. An O scale layout with lots of animation! Then Mark showed us some of his handi-work and suggested several ways to get cheap effects. For light flashers, use free giveaways from seminars, etc... take apart and re-wire; Minitronics makes flashing LED's; dollar store cheap fiber optic toys - take apart and use. For sound modules to buy-Dream Player brand for up to 4 sounds. Other things to try are vehicle lights, doors open/close using switch machines and a simple cable system! Neat stuff! Thanks Mark for sharing your knowledge!

Division 8 Layout Tour October 19, 2008 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm

Al Crowley's Port Huron Northern 14509 Four Lakes Drive, Sterling Heights, MI 48313 (586) 566-3863

The Port Huron Northern is an HO layout 23' x 28'. It is a fictitious line that operates between Port Huron and Saginaw in the late 1950's. Motive power is a mix of steam and early diesel locomotives, all sound equipped. The power is Digitrax DCC. Scenery is approximately 70% complete and is just reaching the point of adding small details in many areas.

The route from Port Huron to Saginaw passes through Brown City, Marlette, Montrose and Burt before arriving in Saginaw. There are several industries along the way to provide local traffic plus interchanges at both ends.

Farm products and industrial goods provide for several trains each way during the day. A passenger train operates on an every-other-day schedule between Detroit and Saginaw. It leaves Detroit Monday, Wednesday and Friday for Saginaw and returns Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

Jim Dennis' New York Central 2733 Denise Dr., Troy, MI 48085 (248) 879-0840

This HO version of the New York Central features a double track main in a folded dog-bone configuration with a generous 400 ft. mainline. It is an around-the-walls plan occupying a 24' X 31' basement. It has three yards and four hidden staging tracks. The track is laid with 32" minimum radius curves and a 1.5 % maximum grade. Mainline turnouts are number 8s, while the yard turnouts are number 6s. The control system is Digitrax Radio DCC.

Although the layout follows the New York Central prototype, it is largely freelanced (and includes some CB&Q). It is set in the era from the late 1950s to the mid 60s.
