The history lesson was from the 1889 publication of station agents - The article talked about how all railroads were to be different gauges, so that freight and passengers had to be transferred between railroads, thus increasing revenue and employment. Between Cleveland and Erie, there were up to 8 different railroads of different gauge, for only 180 miles! But soon, many railroads were consolidated and track standards were in place. The article also mentioned the typical freight box and it's journey through all of the interchanging railroads. Yikes... what a journey! THANKS John! Good to have you back!
