

RAILROAD HISTORY

John Bopp was at the meeting and gave this lesson... From a 1885 Free Press article... Before Detroit was known for autos, we were known for railroad cars! Peninsular Car Company had over 700 employees and was building 15-20 cars a day when it started in 1885! Boxcars, flatcars, stock cars cabooses and others were all built here. These cars were made for many of the major railroads in the area and country. The factory did all of their own work forging, casting and stamping besides the assembly of the cars. The factory buildings were designed for a straight line assembly process and also had advanced water systems for fire fighting. The company was part of a merger in 1899 forming AFC -American Car and Foundry Company. Thanks John! We're looking forward to another lesson soon.




