
5th DIV 6 MODEL RR SALE

THE OBSERVATION CAR

So, if you got a Lionel Santa Fe F3, you probably would start your "real model railroad layout" with that line. An extension of those feelings could simply come from how "cool" that warbonnet paint scheme was, and if one looked great, 20 would look even better!

I'm sure some folks model a line, simply because they rode that line when they were younger, so they want to model that personal travel experience to some extent.

There's probably a pretty large group of model railroaders who model a line, not just for the railroad itself, but for the beautiful terrain that line ran through. You might be really inspired by modeling the cliffs, rivers or farmlands that you are sure would make your layout look like a work of art.

You might even model a line that is gone, just because it is gone, and you miss seeing it!

So, yes there are lots of really good reasons, and more importantly, lots of great memories triggered by the decision you make to model a particular line or place. All of them have one thing in common - you get a really warm and cozy feeling because of that particular decision.

Let me know what you think, and if you have another reason, you made the decision for the line or lines you decided to model. I'll bet there are some other really interesting stories behind your decision I haven't thought of.
